Updates:

- Dialog continues with City about placement of garbage cans. They cannot pursue until they start their next fiscal year – which would be July 1st. At that point, we will find out more.
- Ken Yaeger's office is pursuing getting the location at Bird & Fisk officially declared a "park". We are still trying to get info on why Fuller Plaza cannot also be declared a park. It's now classified as an "undeveloped lot".
- The Code Enforcement walk went pretty well. The director and supervisor were present, as well as Ken Yaeger. The walk included "hot spots" and other generic areas. Code Enforcement will act on a number of situations, but did not get specific. They'll get back to us.
- Tomorrow morning (5/23) Vehicle Abatement will make a sweep in our area & sooner or later streets and curbs will be looked at further. Code Enforcement will be back!! We want to see improves made in a positive way.
- Railroad has said they are going to put in a fence by tracks at Fuller Plaza.
 Should get City involved and propose a decent looking fence. We have already requested "balls" on top if mesh fence is going to be used. We may not get any input at all on this.
- By Laws are completed. Contact Alison if you want a copy.
- Neighborhood Spruce Up day will be held on Sunday, June 3 @ 9am. Meet at Bird & Fuller & bring yard tools. Fences need to be painted and weeding throughout neighborhood. Will have to contact Kwanis Club, who has apparently adopted the space at Bird & Fisk.
- Renee spoke regarding Fuller Plaza. Showed new aerial photographs and initial plans. Plans can include formalizing sidewalks, interplanting new trees for sound buffer, benches, flowers & shrubs, kids park horse, boulders, picnic tables, trash cans, meandering path, new surface, irrigation system, existing tree pruning. Renee will do larger scale plan.
