Updates/Announcements:

- We have joined a coalition of Neighborhood Associations. Many benefits to this and networking resources.
- Meeting was held concerning the buildings off of Willow. Zoned commercial being changed to residential. If anyone is interesting in preserving those buildings, contact Allison.
- The Taxi Cab building is still slated for demolition and development. If anyone is interested, we can set up a special meeting to find out more information.
- Our last "spruce up" day was very successful. Our next one is scheduled for Saturday, June 30, at 9am. Meet across from 526 Fuller. Lunch will be served at the Smokehouse.
- Bird and Fisk is now an official "park". Kwanis club who previously adopted that area, is happy, too.
- The railroad fence will only be put up at the very end of Fuller. It's not in their budget this year to go any further. Railroad has committed to cleaning up and pulling weeds over by Jerome. They want our intents put in writing.
- Dumpster Days are currently on a 5 year cycle. We need to acquire grant money until we can pay for our own. It's approximately \$40 per dumpster.
- Traffic Calming – there is money in the city budget. We have not thrown in our hat yet. We need to get a group working on this. The August election time will be a good time to think about which groups you are interested in getting involved with.
- We are currently doing a little research and getting some contacts regarding possibly designating our neighborhood as a preservation area. We also need a group committed to working on this project.
- Bike park has been bulldozed near railroad tracks. They are researching into relocating.

Our guest speakers were Mike Hannon and Diane Buchanan from Code Enforcement. For code enforcement issues or questions, call Diane at 277.8430. Counsel just passed blight ordinance and several other ordinances such as inoperable vehicles. These ordinances will probably go into effect on September 1. A discussion was held regarding violations, jurisdictional issues, etc. A list of properties/complaints/status, which was the result of the walk through, was distributed.
